

Reuter Theater Organ

2 Manuals, 5 Ranks
blower not included



This organ was built in 1928 and installed in the El Morro Theatre in Gallup, New Mexico. It was later moved to the First Baptist Church in Los Cruces, New Mexico. In 1996, it became available and returned to Reuter. After storing it at our facility for a number of years, we completed some renovations on the instrument, and it is set up and playing in our assembly room.

All the original pipe work and chests are intact. The original orchestral bells and chimes have been releathered. The console has been restored using vintage Reuter keyboards to replace the originals, and Peterson solid-state components from our inventory have been used to upgrade the operating system.

The instrument is currently housed in an enclosure that is 10' 10" X 9' 11" and 13' 2" high (simply designed for the available space on our assembly room mezzanine) but could be laid out in any number of ways.
